We will return after the school day ends, around 16.00 (traffic dependent).

The trip will involve a human geography investigation in Manchester City Centre. Pupils will need a packed lunch and drink with them, there will not be time to go into shops. Please wear school uniform but bring weather appropriate additional clothing (sun cream if it is warm, coat if it is cold or wet).

A voluntary contribution for the cost of the trip is £16.00. If there is insufficient income to cover the cost of the trip a local alternative will have to be used. Please pay via ParentPay by **15.30 on 7th June**. As with all educational visits, we do not wish financial circumstances to preclude your child from participating. 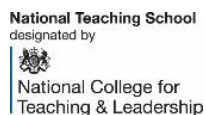
A camera/camera phone would also be useful however we will also take pictures for students to use within this work. We cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to these items.

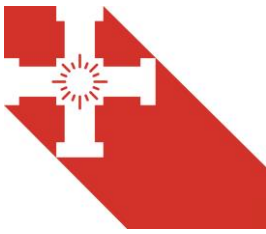

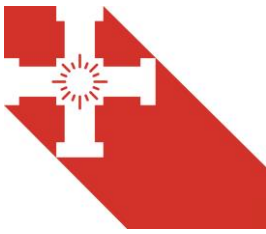

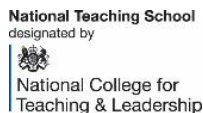
