EXCLUSION & SUSPENSION ARRANGEMENTS

At All Hallows we are keen to avoid exclusions / suspensions wherever possible. However, a student will be excluded from lessons or school when he/she has breached the College's Rewards & Behaviour Policy seriously or persistently. This is a serious sanction and will be considered in light of the conduct in question and by taking into account the College's 'consequence' system. Our College uses internal exclusions & suspensions (formerly known as fixed-term external exclusions).

When deciding whether to internally exclude / suspend a student, the Principal considers the College's responsibilities under the Equality Act 2010. He will also only internally exclude / suspend after a full investigation has taken place in order to ascertain what has happened and why.

On internally excluding / suspending a student, the Principal will notify parents/carers of the period of the internal exclusion / suspension and the reasons for it.

In the case of suspensions, he will also inform parents/carers of their right to make representations about the exclusion to the Local Governing Body.

During the suspension the student is expected to be at home and work will be provided. Parents/carers are required to attend a reintegration meeting following the suspension prior to the student's return to lessons.
