Year 13 Leaving arrangements 2023

I hope you are all well. We are fast approaching Year 13's final weeks here at All Hallows. The first event that marks their leaving was the Staff v Sixth Form Football match. I would like to confirm arrangements for students over the course of the next few months for leaving events and exams.

**Sixth Form Leavers Mass** period 4 Tuesday 16 May. Students may leave college at 13.35.

**Leavers Afternoon** 11.15 Friday 19 May Students should attend college from 11.15 onwards (they are welcome to come in earlier to revise), they may wear their own clothes (no inappropriate slogans). Students will have awards in College and then walk to Fina for a meal. Students should complete online order form and pay by Thursday 18 May at the latest on Parentpay.

**Leavers Dinner** 30 June in Manchester, students should pay £30 online by end of the day Monday 15 May. If this is an issue but a student wants to go please can they come and see Mr Howells to reserve their place.

## Exams

Some students have already completed Art, Sport, and Business exams this week. Formal A level exams begin on Wednesday 17 May. You may also be aware that Wednesday 28 June has been identified by the exam boards as the 'contingency' exam date, in case of any 'widespread, sustained national or local disruption to examinations during the June 2023 examination series. Students should be available up until that date.

Following the Leavers Afternoon on the 19 May, students will no longer be required to attend form in the morning or stay in College during non-contact study periods. They are expected to attend their lessons as normal until they have completed examinations in that subject. Obviously if they have an exam they will go to that instead.

Students are expected to attend exams in full business dress, failure to do this may result in entry to the exam room being refused. The same applies to attendance to College throughout the exam period.

Year 13 have been a pleasure to work with this year. They have really worked hard as the build up to exams has come closer, and they will be in our thoughts and prayers throughout the examination period. We thank you for your continued support throughout your child's time in Sixth Form, and hope that we can work together to ensure they shine this summer.
