Dear Parent / Carer,

I am pleased to be able to share with you information about the end of Year 11 rewards day on Monday 24th June. This is a trip to congratulate the students on a successful year and to celebrate all of their achievements, including finishing their GCSE exams.

The coach will depart from College at approximately 9.30, following our Leavers' Assembly. It will leave Alton Towers to arrive back at school at around 6pm. Parents are asked to note that as the coaches will not return to college until after the school day, arrangements will need to be made to pick up those students who usually travel on the College bus. Students will be accompanied by staff on the trip but will be free to explore the park in friendship groups, with staff stationed in various areas.

The cost per pupil is **£35.00**, which includes travel and entry ticket. Please pay and provide consent via ParentPay **by Friday 14th June 2024**. If we do not receive the payment and consent details by this date, then your child may not be able to go on the visit. If your child receives free school meals/pupil premium, please speak to the finance office if you require help with the cost of the trip trips@allhallows.org.uk.

Students can choose to either take a packed lunch or money to purchase food/refreshments throughout the day.

As with all trips out of college, we expect the highest standards of behaviour. We reserve the right to remove a student from the fieldtrip or if their behaviour in college ahead of the trip is very poor. This would be a serious concern in terms of health and safety on this school trip. There would be no refund on payment if the student is removed from the trip on poor behaviour grounds.

For students to take part in all of the above activities they must meet the following criteria:

- Students must remain in positive SHINE points for the remainder of this half term
- Students must not be issued with an Emmaus or Suspension from College this half term
- Students must have good attendance and consistently wear their uniform to a high standard.
- Students must attend their GCSE examinations.
