## <u>Hope for the Future – Year 6 Transition Residential Experience Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July – Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July '24</u>

To support transition from primary school to All Hallows Catholic College, we have organised a fantastic experience that we hope will be remembered forever. Working with Liverpool Hope University we are running a residential experience, based at the University, from Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July – Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July '24.

The experience will allow your child to celebrate their success at primary school, prepare for life at All Hallows, get to know their fellow students and some of the staff they will be working with in September, as well as experiencing various activities offered by ourselves and the University.

These activities involve three fun-packed days where they will have the opportunity to explore the campus, take part in a range of educational and sporting activities, experience a taste of what University might be like for them, meet University students, experience a lecture and take part in a graduation ceremony for themselves.

The aim of the programme is to provide support and success to every child as they make this important transition between primary and secondary school, raise aspirations, boost achievement and foster a deep love of learning.

The residential will be run by staff from All Hallows, primary schools and Liverpool Hope University.

Accommodation will be provided on-site in University halls of residence. Senior staff at All Hallows are visiting and liaising with the University to make all the arrangements, and a member of the All Hallows leadership team will be present throughout the trip. The full cost of the residential experience will be £160 which includes coach transfer to and from the University, accommodation, meals and the use of the University facilities.
