I am writing to inform you of a visit to the Tate Gallery at The Albert Dock, Liverpool on **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. The purpose of the visit is to focus on themes which relate to the current Year 11 projects and gather research for their GCSE coursework.

We will be travelling by coach and leave school at 09:15. We will return to college at 15:10, in time for the school buses. The cost of the visit will be £15 which is payable via ParentPay no later than Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> September. Students are required to wear their full College uniform/dress code for the duration of the visit. We will be spending some time outdoors and whilst there is overhead covering around the Albert Dock area, suitable outdoor clothing would be advisable, such as a waterproof jacket. Students will be required to gather information on the visit and produce some of their own recording as evidence of what they have looked at in the Gallery and around the Dock area. Cameras/mobile phone cameras are desirable for photography purposes but must be used at the owner's risk. Students should bring their own refreshments and a packed lunch.

The gallery operates a ticketed entry so we will remain in our college groups during the entirety of the visit.

Consent for the trip can be provided in ParentPay when paying, please ensure you complete all the questions required. Students will not be permitted to travel without this completed form.

Behaviour will be assessed on the run up to the trip, any adverse behaviour will be discussed and reported to parents and if improvements are not made then removal from the trip may happen and any money paid towards the trip will not be refunded.
